

Rules for bowling during Covid-19

- Members should arrive no sooner than 10 minutes before start of play and should not gather in the clubhouse or on the patio areas
- No more than 3 people in the clubhouse at the same time, and no more than one person at a time in the restrooms, sheds, office, closets
- Hands should be sanitized before and after play.
- Leave an empty rink between your game and the game next to you.
- Keep to individual practice, singles or pairs. No triples or rinks.
- Maintain a distance of 6 feet from other players.
- There must be no more than 10 players per green
- No spitting or licking of fingers.
- Use a clean towel each game. Take home and launder used towels.
- Scoreboards, chalk and erasers are NOT to be used for keeping score
- If playing singles or pairs, limit the responsibilities of players
 - **Jacks.** Pre-set the jack (preferred) OR only allow one person to pick up/handle the jack for the entire game. Sanitize the jack before and after play.
 - **Mats.** Only allow one person to pick up/handle the mat for the entire game. Sanitise the mat before and after play.
 - **Rakes.** Do not use rakes (preferred) OR designate one person to touch and use the rake for the entire game. Sanitize the rake before and after play.
 - **Measuring.** Do not measure with a tape (preferred) OR if it must be done, limit to one designated person for the entire game without touching the jack or bowls. Sanitize the measure before and after play.
 - **Bowls.** Players should only touch and handle their own bowls for the duration of play. Bowls should be sanitized before and after play.
- Persons must leave the premises immediately after practice/roll up and cleansing of all equipment
- Hand sanitiser and disinfectant must be supplied at entrance to club/greens and stationed at each green in use
- All bowlers must wear face masks while on club premises.
