Hello Members,

I'm addressing all of you, in case you may have overlooked noting your interest to support the Hospitality Committee.

The Hospitality Committee is responsible for logistics and snacks for events held at the green.

Before the Event,

Suggest to the BOD type of event (holiday, seasonal or just fun) or food option. Within the general guidelines provided by the BOD, purchase snacks, water, sports drinks and/or other items required.
Launder the bowls towels. (Weekly, or as needed.)

At the beginning of the Event:

Set up tents, folding tables, umbrellas, chairs, rakes/mats/jacks/chalk.
Set up food tables, picnic tables, coolers, ice or other stations required for the event.

During the Event:

Be prepared for the unexpected: wind, thunder, rain, spills, accidents, etc.
Ensure the food tables or other stations are tidy.

At the end of the Event:

Dismantling, cleaning (if appropriate) and storing the above.
Check site and pick up debris, misplaced items.

The types of events the Hospitality Committee supports are:

SED Tournaments: All day event, 3 games, Breakfast snacks, Lunch snacks. (1/10/26, 1/31/26, 3/21/26)
Club Championships: variable (usually January)
Learn to Bowl, (MW Nov 10,12,17,19 & MTh Jan 5,8,12,15) Open Houses, etc. : variable
SLBC Fun Games: Welcome Back (Sat Nov 8), ProAm (Sat Nov 22), Holidays, Easter, etc: variable

Private Events (Similar to Learn to Bowl, but scheduled for a specific group). Snacks, water, sports drinks.

(First one is Wed Nov 5, 1pm-3pm)

Please reply and indicate if you would like to be included on committee communications, the activity you are able to support and a general indication of when you are available (year round, specific months, days).

In particular consider if you can assist with the events in November.

If you volunteer you will still be able to participate and enjoy the event !
