President's Preamble:

The Green:

Work continues on our green. Greenskeeper Tom Hilferty is still struggling with issues with our temperamental irrigation system. Failing batteries in the head controllers and debris in the reclaimed water that constantly clog the sprinkler heads are ongoing challenges. One of the heads blew recently, causing damage to the green. Thank you to Jim Sparrow and Tom for repairing the damage. Work has begun on a new underground filter to remove debris from the reclaimed water. Updates to the irrigation system will be performed after that project is complete.

Tom has moved healthy plugs of sod to the bare areas, and is waiting for them to spread and fill in. Verticutting and new grass plugs have resulted in some signs of improvement on the green.

Fungicide is currently being applied to combat the algae on the green.

REMINDER: ALWAYS WASH YOUR HANDS AFTER BOWLING!
Pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers are regularly applied to our green.

The SED lists 'open' tournaments (open to members outside their own club), and organizes various inter-club leagues and championships. SED Board members meet in December and March.
