News from the President:

I want to share some great news that I just received today. The City of Sarasota's Parks and Recreation Department will be starting construction of sidewalks around the green on Monday, December 1! I have been informed that the contractor will **complete the east and west sides by December 11**th and the north and south sides on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. After the sidewalks are completed, we expect that the City will be permanently "lending" us portable, flushable restrooms early in 2026. Apparently, a contractor showed up recently and told us that he has been requested to run an electrical cable from our main panel to where the restrooms will go (at the S-W corner of the green), so fingers crossed that it will happen soon.


It is expected that there will be minimal disruption to lawn bowling or croquet. When the east and west sidewalks are being constructed, we can bowl north-south, and vice versa when the N-S sidewalks are being built. Remember that we can also park on the opposite side of Circus Blvd if necessary.
